

Centennial Park Enhancement Project Gets Underway....

You may have noticed some recent action at the northeast corner of Centennial Park, on Dr. Leach Dr.

Manotick Culture, Parks and Recreation Association in partnership with the City of Ottawa, and with the generous support of the Tomlinson Foundation, are undertaking a facelift to this gateway to Centennial Park, now commemorated as the David Arntfield Recreation Area.



Phase 1 got underway in late September with the removal of the Outdoor Rink boards. The work will be completed by December 2020 and include a paved Basketball/ Outdoor Rink surface with proper lighting.
