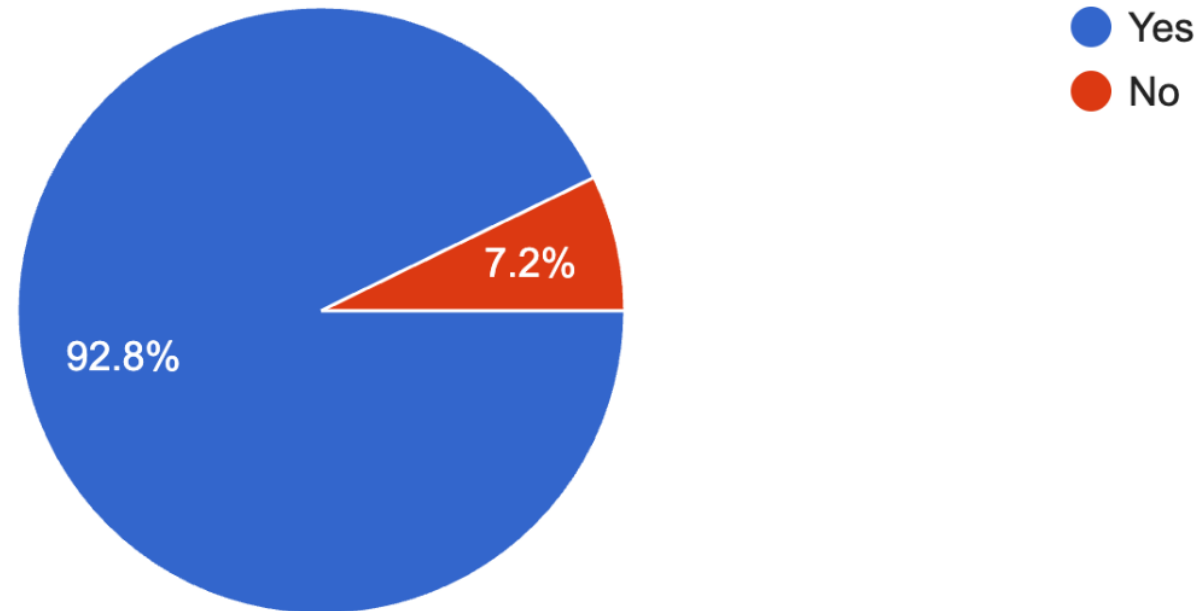

180 responses

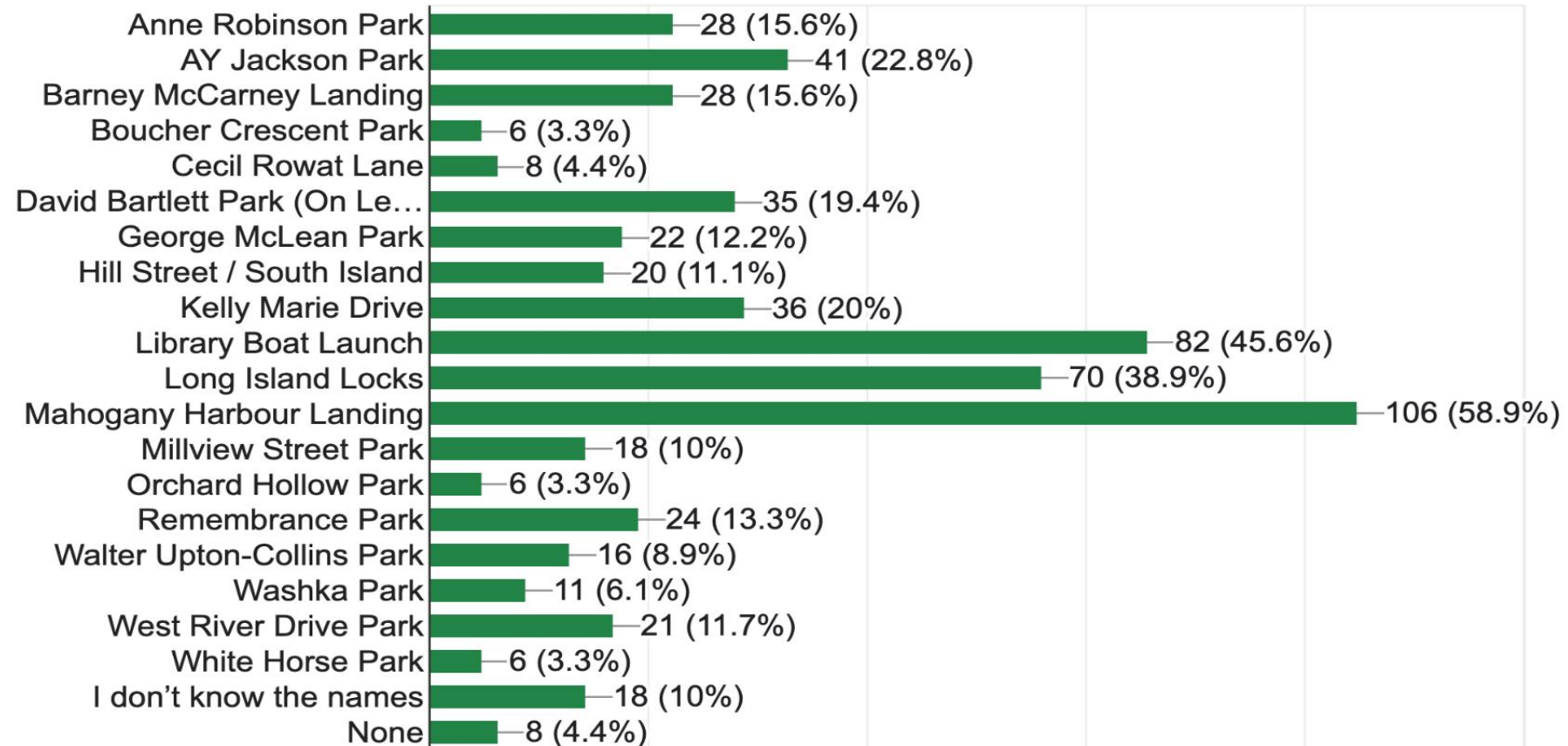

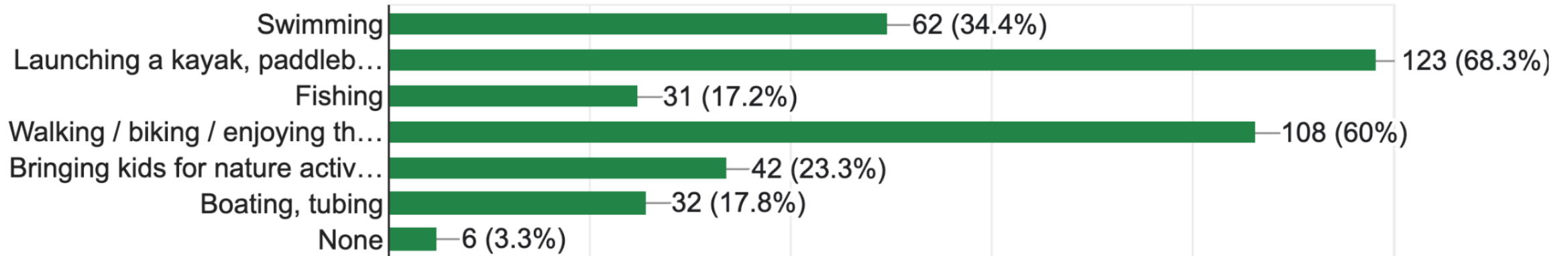

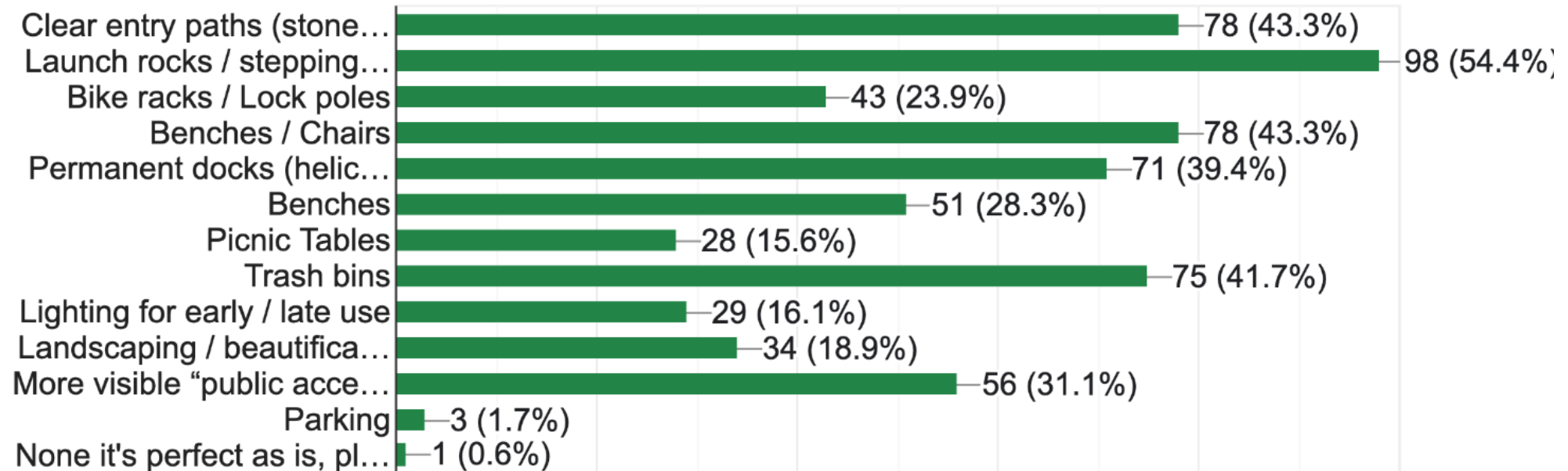

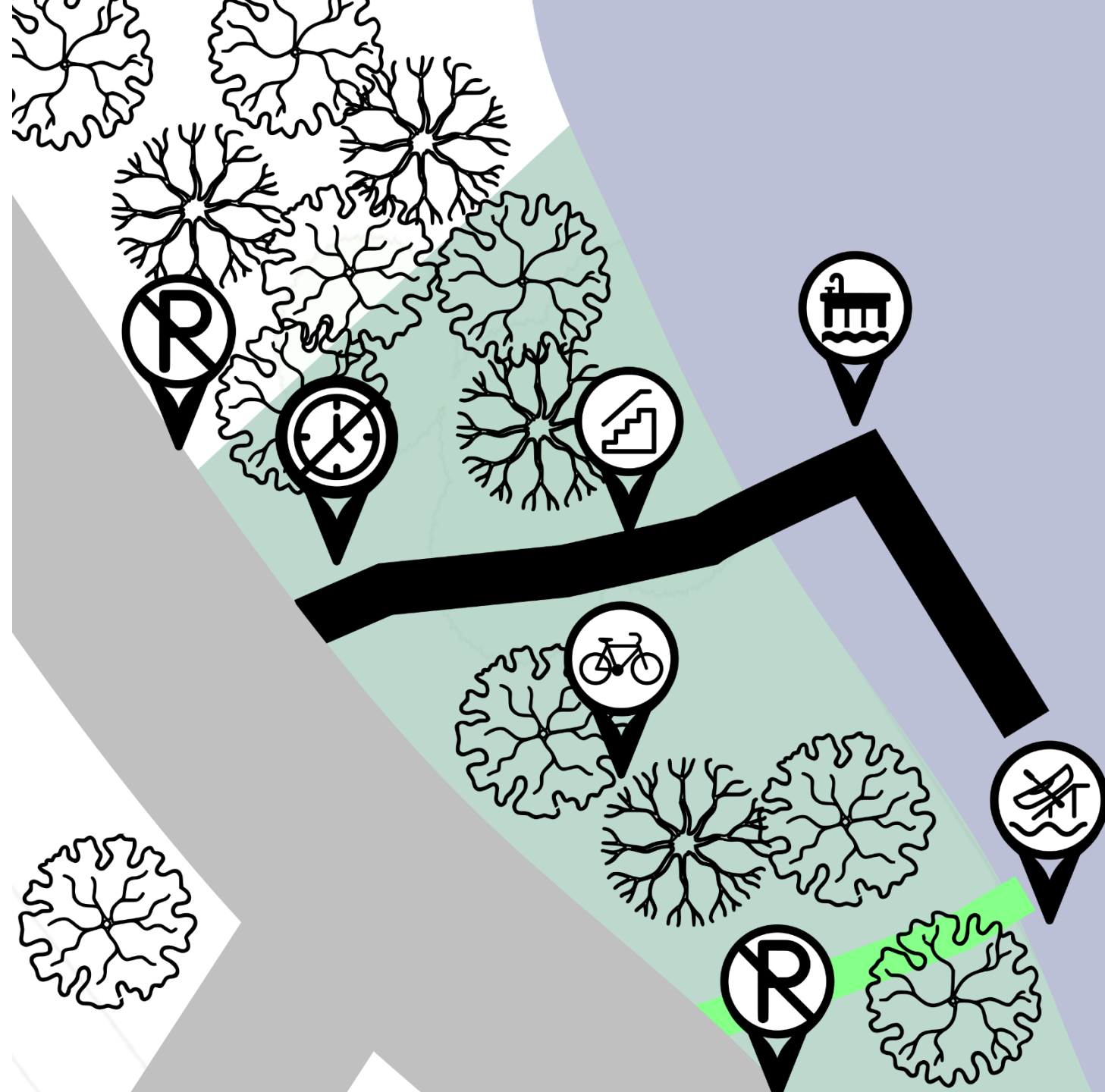

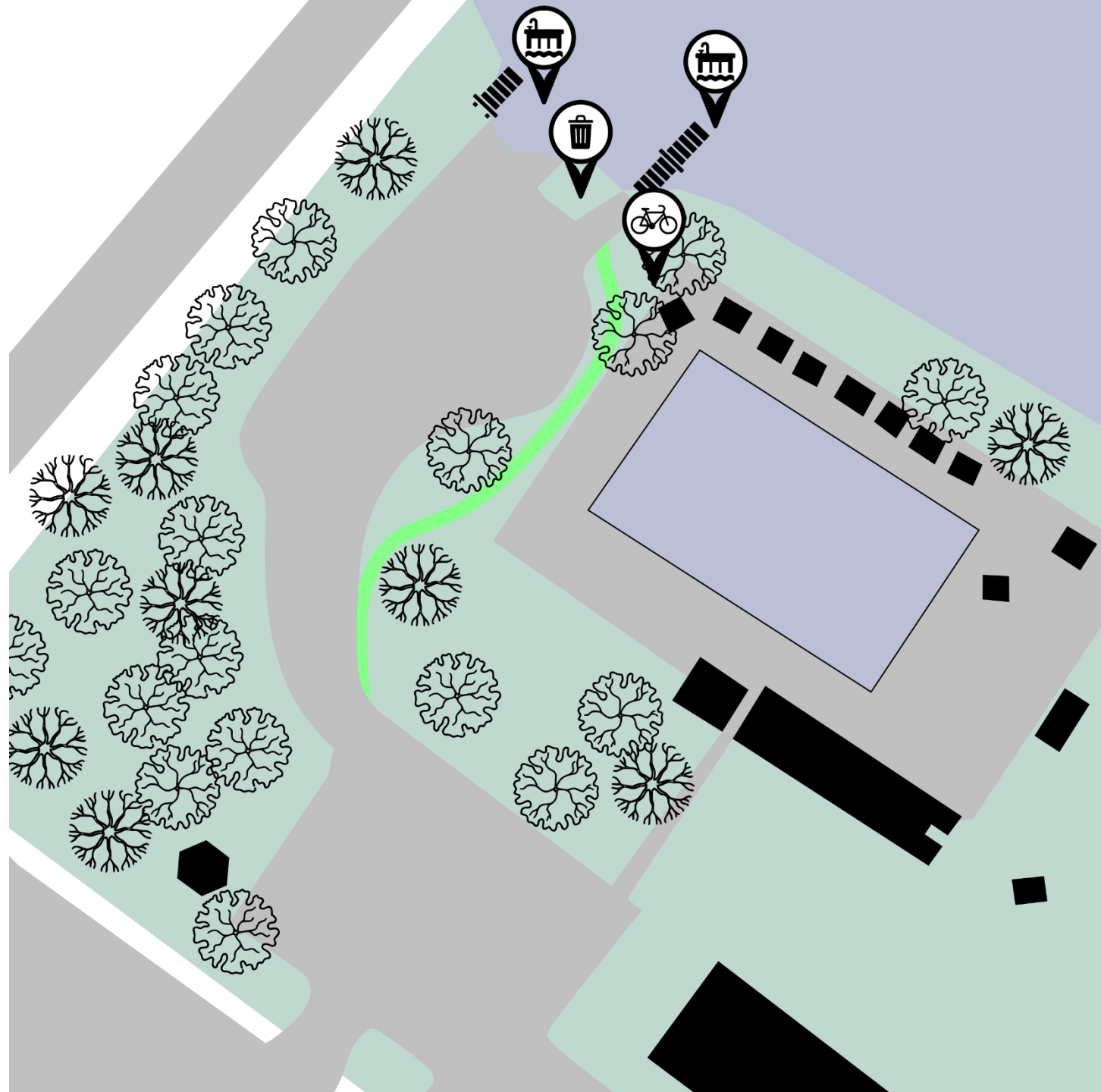

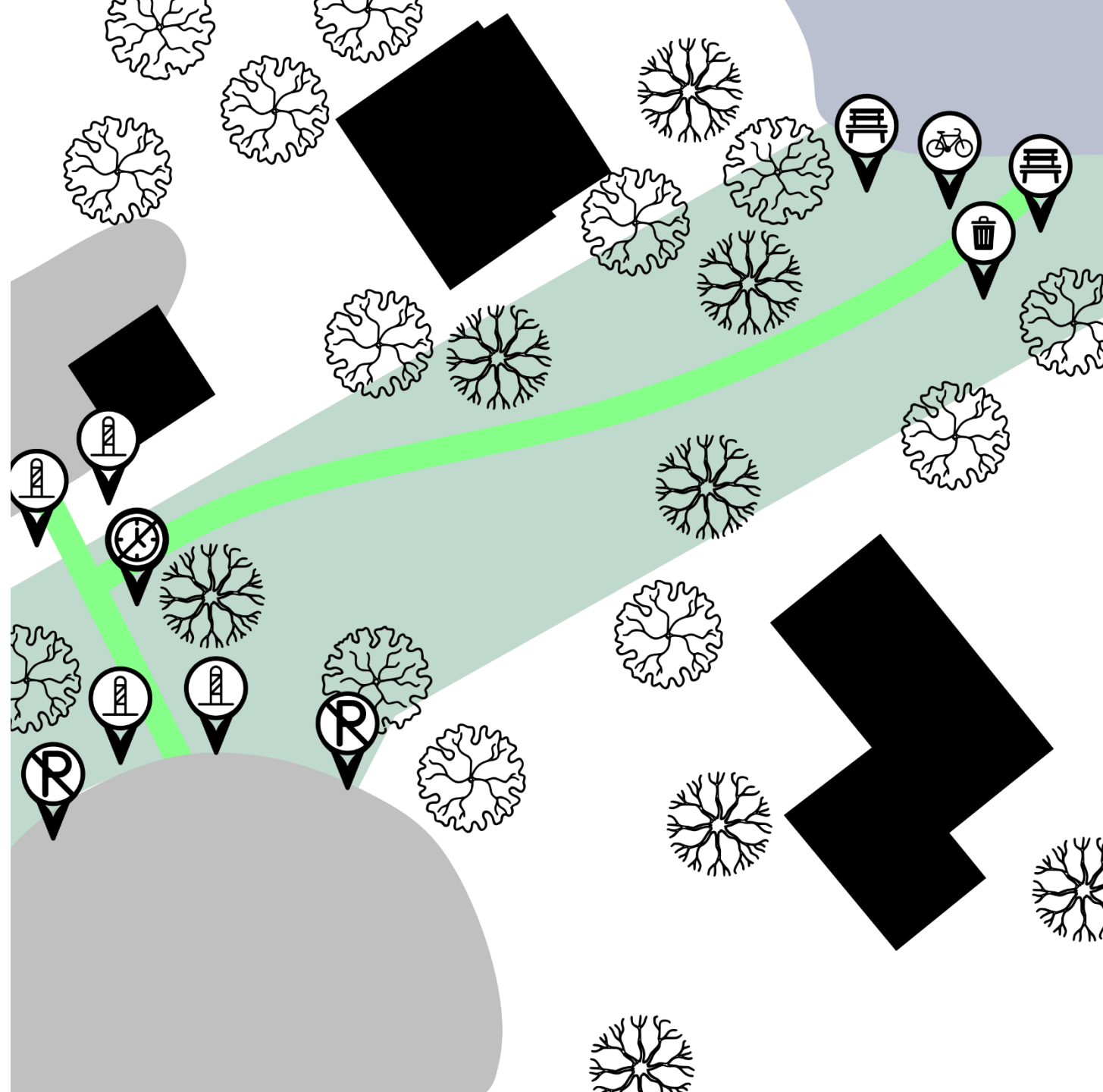

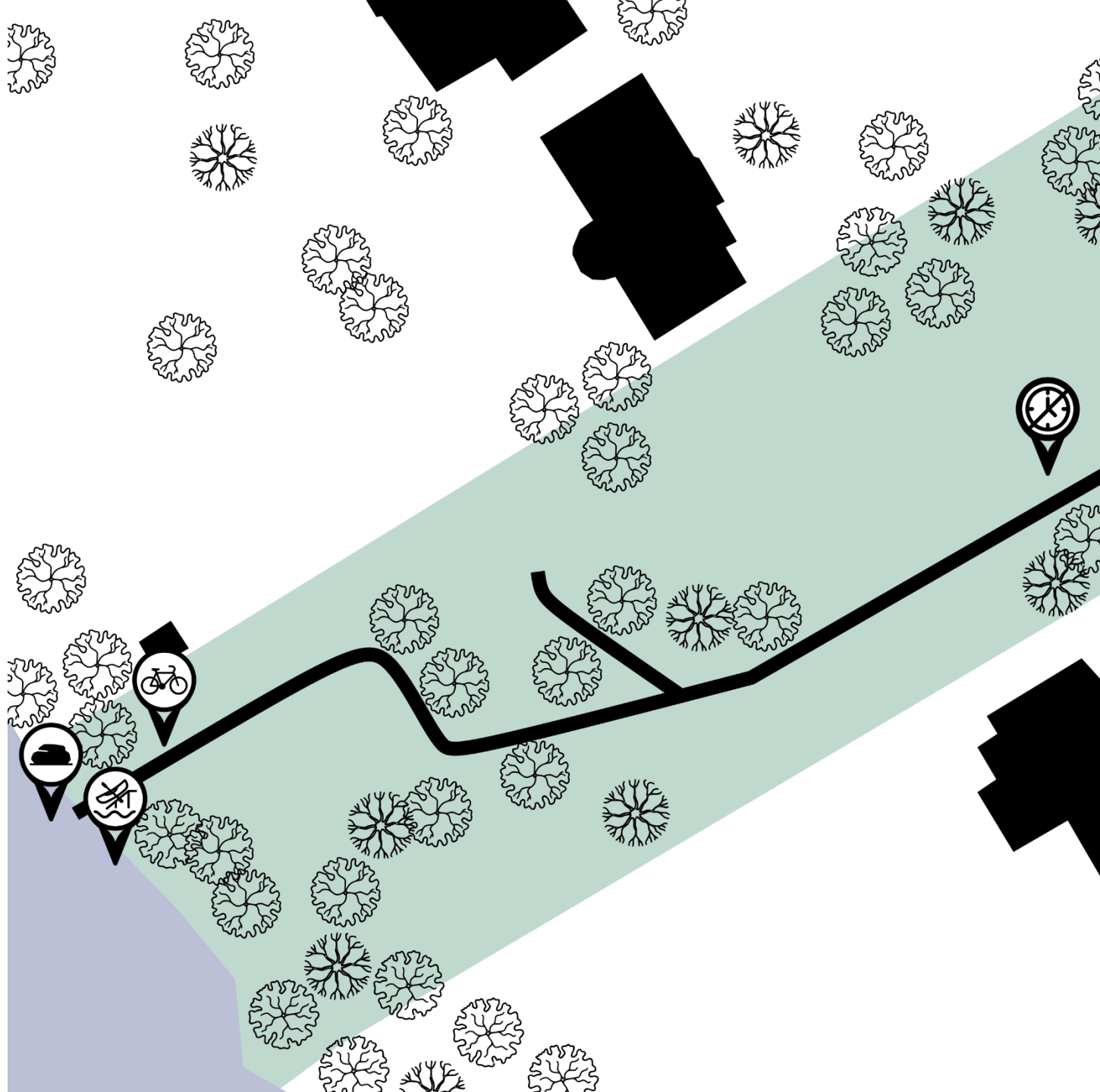

WATER ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS

NEXT STEPS / WAI PROJECT DELIVERABLES

1. Finalize Concept Plans based on additional community feedback / public meeting
2. Obtain partner approvals for Concept Plans (i.e. City Park Planning, RVCA, Parks Canada)
3. Sign Partnership Agreement with City Parks Planning for design / build
4. Identify monetary sources and potential grant applications
5. Establish Partner Management Team for Design / Build phases
6. Get Partner approval of site(s) requiring detailed design(s)
7. Prepare / Issue Request For Quotations (RFQs) for Detailed Design(s)
8. Evaluate quotations and award contract to lowest compliant bidder
9. Develop Build project schedule with successful bidder
10. Obtain partner approvals for Detailed Design document(s)
11. Prepare / Issue RFQs for Build requirements
12. Evaluate quotations and award contract to lowest compliant bidder
13. Develop Build project schedule with successful bidder and partners
14. Manage Build project with partners until final acceptance and turnover to City
15. Project Completion
